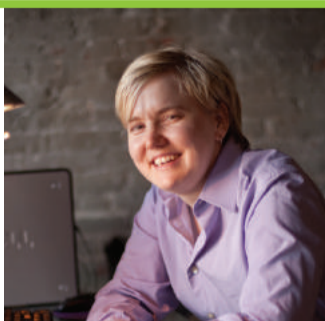
## Speakers:



**Dawn Allbee, MA**, will speak on the topic of *Improving Quality and Safety through Change Management*. Ms. Allbee serves as the Joint Commission's Director of Corporate Robust Process Improvement. Her presentation will discuss the use of rapid process improvement methods as a means to achieve important strategic and operational goals in an organization.
